

Full Fee Paying International Student Pathway Study Plan Policy

Statement of Intent


The Royal Oak Primary School Board of Trustees will ensure that;

- 1) All students will be placed in a mainstream classroom suited to the age of the student.
- 2) The ESOL teacher will make contact with the student and familiarise him/her with the location of the ESOL room as required.
- 3) All students from Year 3 upwards will participate in the ESOL programme best suited to his/her level of English.
- 4) As appropriate, additional small group programmes to support English acquisition are provided. This may involve out of school visits to further knowledge of New Zealand culture and local points of interest.
- 5) All students will take part in the mainstream classroom programme at all other times.
- 6) Teachers involved with Full Fee Paying International Students will be aware of the need to provide careful attention to English acquisition in the first instance.
- 7) All students will participate in the New Zealand Curriculum programmes planned for the mainstream classes.
- 8) Regular assessments will be undertaken to ensure the learning programme is accurately set and that academic progress is being made.
- 9) All students and their parents are provided with regular feedback about their academic progress. Students studying for 3 weeks or less will receive a certificate.


