Outcome statement

The Royal Oak Primary School Board of Trustees, with the Principal and teaching staff will ensure that;

- 4) reports are prepared and shared on the progress and achievement of students as a whole and of groups including the progress and achievement of Māori students against the plans and targets referred to in the strategic plan.


